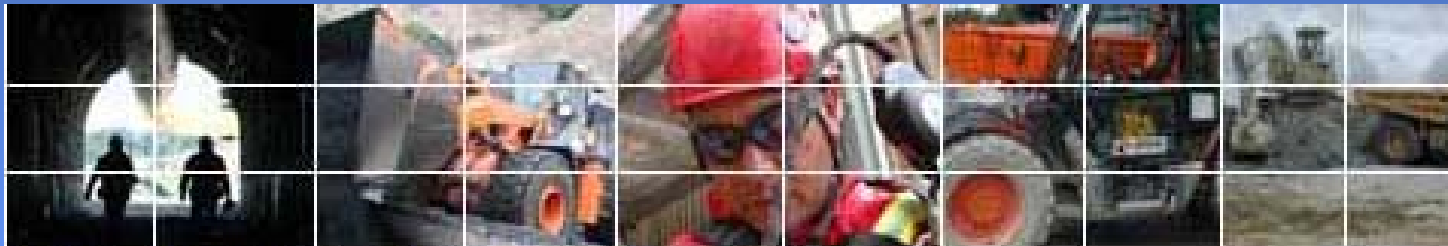

- **Strategy Adopted March 2006**

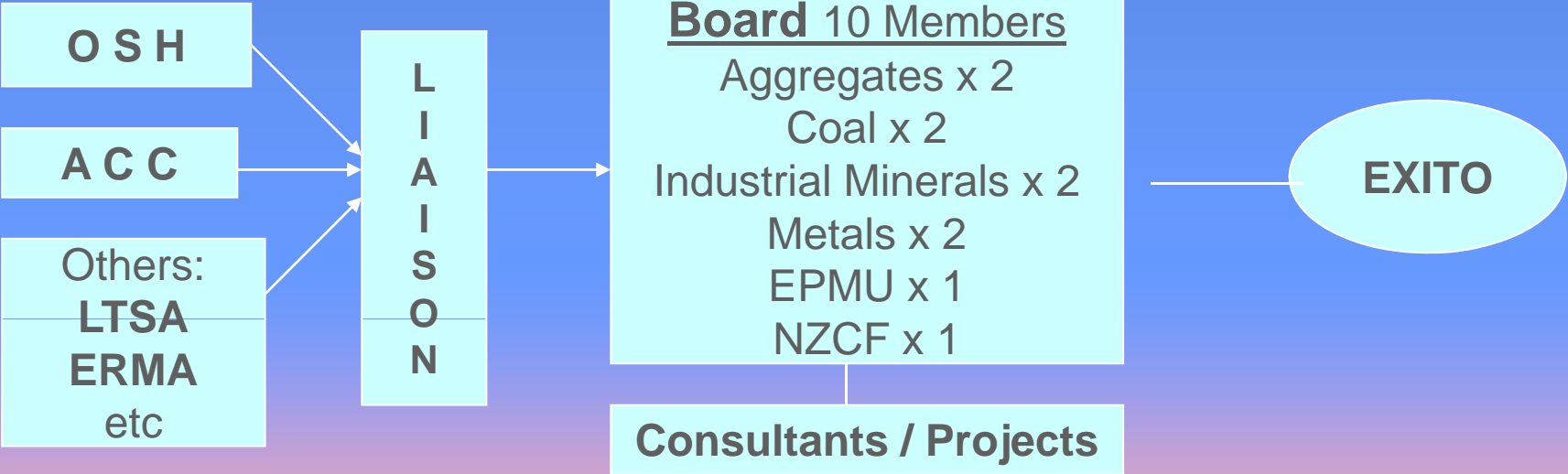
- Coordinate provision of meaningful health and safety information and resources to industry

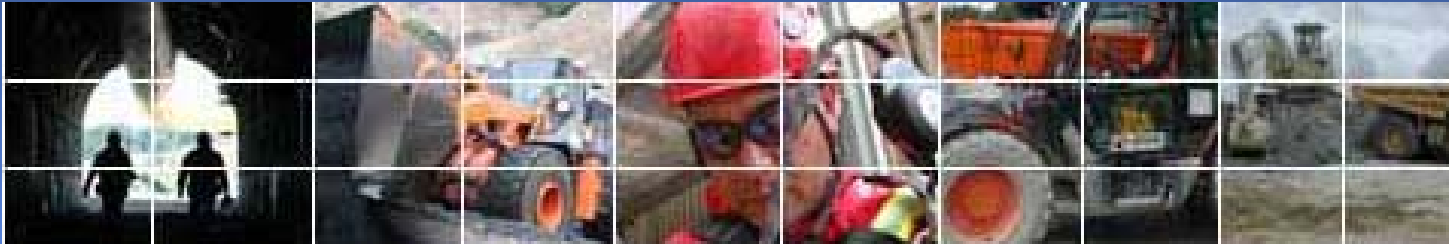
